

Chemservice opens office in Turkey

As a candidate country for EU Membership, Turkey has accelerated the process to implement new chemical legislation. This includes a REACH-like regulation and the implementation of GHS/CLP. The Turkish Regulation on the Inventory and Control of Chemicals requires as well the submission of a notification for existing substance based on tonnage ranges to set-up the new chemical inventory. The deadline for notification in order to install the Chemical Inventory has been established at March 31st 2011. All further nominations will be regarded as new substances, which require a more complex registration procedure. Safety Data Sheets in Turkish language are required as well. In order to protect confidential business information a "Trustee" function (comparable to the Only Representative of REACH) was integrated into the new law.

As long as Turkey is not a member of the EU, all newly introduced legislation has to be separately addressed by companies doing business in Turkey.
